Installation Guide

Euromats



1. Euromats are delivered on a pallet of 25no max weighing in at 900kg/pallet.
2. Customer is responsible for unloading and loading delivery vehicle unless install has been requested (charges apply). Euromats must be stacked and securely attached to the pallet on collection.
3. Each Euromat weighs 33kg and is a two-man lift. They can be joined together with a standard plastic connector which is supplied with every hire, you will require a 17mm socket or spanner to tighten the connection bolts.
4. For tracks and vehicle access, the Euromats are laid end to end and connected with a two-way connector at each corner.
5. For pads and compounds areas additional four-way connectors can be used where mats join at the corners.
6. Additional steel strap connectors can be used on two-way and four-way configuration to increase the rigidity of the Euromat.
7. The customer has the option to lay and install the Euromat or we offer full installation service (charges apply)
8. On a wet and boggy ground geotextile sheet can be laid under the Euromat to prevent mud coming through the joins (charges apply)
